

2025 Managing General Agents - Built for What's Next

In 2024, MGAs sustained their strong growth momentum, once again outpacing the broader property-casualty insurance market. This expansion in premiums was driven by persistent hard market conditions across multiple segments and continued access to underwriting capacity through fronting insurers. Additionally, MGA premiums backed by Lloyd's syndicates— longstanding leaders in supporting MGAs in the U.S.—rose by 14% during the year



2025 Focus 2024 Property-Casualty Loss Reserves Meet the New Year, Same as the Old Year

The 2025 Strategic Study on Loss Reserves delivers a timely analysis of the U.S. property-casualty insurance industry's reserve adequacy as of year-end 2024. Despite a challenging macroeconomic backdrop including inflation, legal system volatility, and rising claim severity, the industry maintained a 3.7% reserve redundancy. The industry also experienced its 19th consecutive year of recording favorable reserve development from prior accident years.



2025 Individual Annuity Profitability

The 2025 Individual Annuity Profitability Review delivers a comprehensive, data-driven assessment of which companies truly succeeded in converting record annuity sales into long-term profitability. While headlines have focused on the surge in sales from 2020 to 2024, this report shifts the lens to performance, highlighting which insurers maximized returns. Drawing on statutory return-on-revenue metrics, Conning evaluates the top 75 individual annuity writers accounting for nearly the entire market. The report uncovers how strategic shifts in product mix, investment allocation, reinsurance usage, and distribution channels impacted performance.



2025 Commercial Auto Insurance Market - Challenges and Opportunities

Conning's 2025 Commercial Auto Study delivers an analysis of one of the insurance industry's most challenging sectors. Despite 13 years of rate hikes, commercial auto insurance remains deeply unprofitable, with claims costs and legal pressures outpacing premium growth. The study reveals how persistent underwriting losses, rising litigation, and economic volatility have created a market in crisis—2024 alone saw a \$5 billion net underwriting loss and a combined ratio of 107%. This report explores the evolving risk landscape, including the impact of driver shortages, nuclear verdicts, supply chain disruptions, and the rapid adoption of electric vehicles.
